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## Tri-City Medical Center Earns Highest Possible Hospital Safety Score for Sixth Consecutive Time

Oceanside, Calif., April 27, 2016 – [Tri-City Medical Center](#) earned its sixth successive A grade in the national Hospital Safety Score ratings program recognizing its exceptional patient safety record. Of the 798 hospitals nationwide to receive the A rating, only five were in San Diego County and Tri-City Medical Center was the only one in North County.

The Hospital Safety Score is the gold standard rating for patient safety, compiled under the guidance of the nation's leading patient safety experts and administered by [The Leapfrog Group](#), a national patient safety watchdog.

"The safety of our patients is of utmost importance, and our board is proud to know that the physicians, nurses and caretakers at Tri-City Medical Center are doing their part to maintain our high standards," said James Dagostino, Tri-City Healthcare District Board Chair.

Developed under the guidance of Leapfrog's Blue Ribbon Expert Panel, the Hospital Safety Score uses 30 measures of publicly available hospital safety data to assign A, B, C, D and F grades to more than 2,500 U.S. hospitals twice per year. It is calculated by top patient safety experts, peer-reviewed, fully transparent and free to the public. For the first time, the Hospital Safety Score includes five measures of patient-reported experience with the hospital as well as two of the most common infections, C.diff and MRSA.

"Avoidable deaths in hospitals should be the number one concern of our health care leaders. Hospitals that earn an 'A' from Leapfrog are leaders in saving lives, and we commend them and urge their continued vigilance," said Leah Binder, president and CEO of The Leapfrog Group.
