WELCOME TO TRI-CITY MEDICAL CENTER

This guide provides information to make your visit easier and more enjoyable. Maps to departments and services as well as available parking are located inside. The information desk is located in the lobby inside the Main Entrance, where volunteers can assist you with room directions and other information.

HELPFUL INFORMATION

VISITING HOURS • Most areas: 24 hours a day

Visitors are beneficial to a patient's recovery, yet rest is an important part of each patient's treatment. Therefore, we ask that no more than two visitors be with a patient at one time. Visitation may be restricted during flu season and/or other circumstances.

Neonatal Intensive Care Unit: Our visiting hours are 24 hours

a day, limit 2 at bedside; except during shift change which takes place from 6:45 – 7:45 a.m./pm. One "banded" person must be at bedside with visitor. We do not have child care services and ask that you do not bring young children without someone to watch them while you visit. Children must have current immunization card. Labor and Delivery: Visiting Hours during triage/admissionsignificant other only. Visitors at the bedside allowed. Children under 14 years of age are limited to siblings only, with current immunization card and an adult responsible for their care. Post Partum: Significant others and grandparents: open visiting. General visitors: 8:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m. Limited to 4 visitors per room at one time. If patient is in semiprivate room with a roommate: 2 visitors per patient at a time. Children under 14 years limited to siblings of baby and must have a current immunization card. To provide privacy and confidentiality,

visitors may be requested to wait in designated waiting areas during

physician examinations, nursing care, and the performance of tests

or procedures. **ADULT CRITICAL CARE UNIT**

- Visitors permitted all hours except 7:00 a.m. 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.
- Family only, two at a time. Children under 14 not permitted. • No flowers or plants allowed.
- **DINING AREA**

The hospital cafeteria is located in the lower lever (LL) and is open for service 6:00 a.m. - 1:30 a.m. daily.

Coffee Cart hours: Located on the main floor in the lobby. Monday – Friday, 6:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., closed weekends.

GIFT SHOP

- The hospital Auxiliary operates a Gift Shop in the main lobby. Items available include candy, magazines, toiletries, cards, games, flowers, and a variety of gifts.
- The Gift Shop is open Monday Friday, 9:00 a.m. 7:30 p.m. Saturday 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m., Sunday 11:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. **PARKING**

Shuttles make regular rounds of the lots and are happy to give you a ride to the hospital.

INFORMATION FOR YOUR SAFETY

SMOKING POLICY As part of our commitment to your good health and safety, Tri-City Medical Center is a completely smoke-free campus.

VALUABLES/PERSONAL ITEMS

- It is in your best interest to leave valuables at home or send them home with family members.
- While we do everything possible to assure the safety and security of your belongings, we cannot assume responsibility for loss or damage to valuables, clothing, or other personal items.
- For money and jewelry that cannot be sent home, a safe in the Business Office is available for your use. Please ask the nurse for further information regarding the use of the hospital safe.
- If you misplace your personal belongings, please notify your nurse.
- Please turn off your cell phone in areas where signs are posted restricting cell phone use.
- Balloons: There are people who have severe allergies to latex. Some balloons are made with latex. The hospital prohibits latex balloons and we ask that Mylar balloons be used. Most florists are aware of this issue and use only Mylar balloons for hospital deliveries.

STANDARD PRECAUTIONS

- Good hand hygiene is our single most important way to prevent disease.
- Occasionally members of your health care team may wear a gown, mask, eye protection, and gloves. This is a precautionary measure to protect you and your healthcare provider against contact with blood and other bodily fluids.
- These procedures are required by the Federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration.


