Course Description & Purpose

The purpose of the Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course is to promote integration of knowledge and skills essential to clinical assessment, promotion, and evaluation of fetal well-being during labor. This two-day course focuses on the application of essential fetal monitoring knowledge and skills used in intrapartum nursing practice. The course consists of didactic and skill station sessions.

Objectives

At the conclusion of this course, participants will:

- Analyze fetal heart patterns, uterine activity, and their implications for fetal well-being
- Discuss indicated clinical interventions and related maternal-fetal physiology
- Effectively communicate verbal and written data about patient status
- Describe the roles and responsibilities of healthcare providers in the use of fetal heart monitoring in intrapartum care
- Demonstrate the psychomotor skills used in FHM

Target Audience

This course is designed for clinicians with a **minimum of 6 months** of perinatal experience using fetal heart monitoring in the intrapartum setting. It is NOT an introductory-level fetal monitoring course.

Course Fees

Cancellation & Refund Policy

Course refunds will be provided if written or telephone cancellation is received by the registration deadline. Cancellations after the deadline and 'no shows' will be charged the full registration fee. A minimum of 7 participants is required to hold the course. If minimum enrollment is not met by the course registration deadline, the course may be canceled.
